Important Changes

1. New bantam ring sizes for Phoenix, Sumatra and Yokohama will only be valid from July 2017.
A and B for hens and B and C for cocks will be acceptable for 2016.
2. New Hampshire: Bantam ring sizes C (hens) and D (cocks) will be acceptable for 2017.
The correct ring sizes (Hens - B and Cocks - C) must be used.

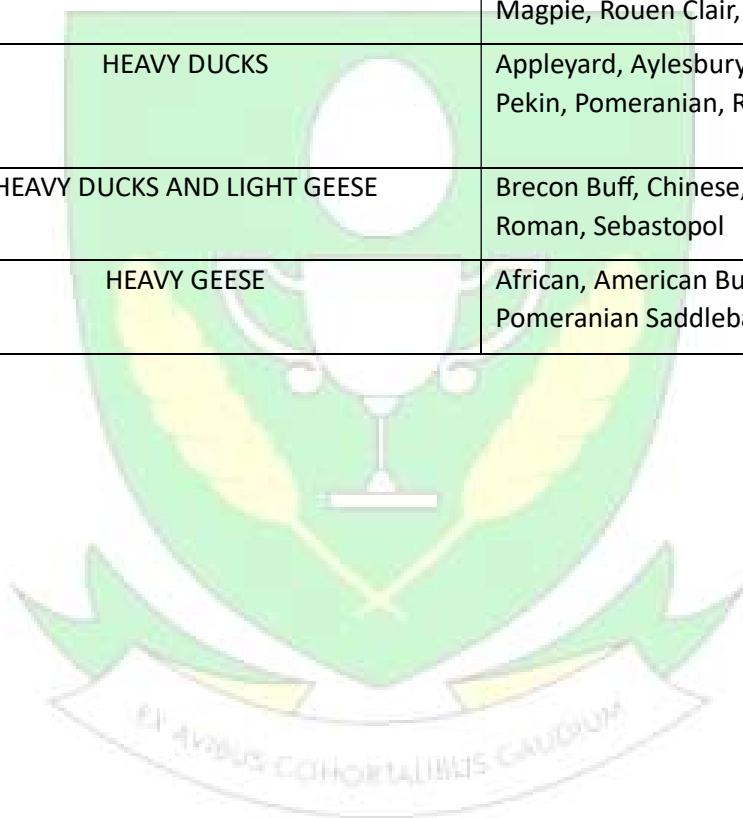
1. Auracana Hen: D rings and Auracana Cock: E rings from 2012; different ring size before 2012 not to be disqualified.

Poultry Rings

NB! : A very important point to remember: Rings are only put on show poultry for IDENTIFICATION PURPOSES.

That said, it does NOT pertain to QUALITY, nor does it identify the bird as a winner or a champion or a pure breed.

- 1.1. From 2005 all exhibits shall bear official sealed rings of the Organisation.
- 1.2. From 2005 no other type of ring or leg band of whatever nature shall be allowed at any type of show (except Agricultural Shows) and any bird wearing such a ring will be disqualified.
- 1.3. Because of public participation in Agricultural Shows, the bearing of sealed rings is not compulsory at these shows. However, no other removable type of ring, cable tie or leg band of whatever nature shall be allowed and must be removed before birds are penned.
- 1.4. Exhibits bearing rings of organisations recognised by SASPO up until 2004 shall not be discriminated against, provided the ring is sealed.
- 1.5. An imported bird wearing a ring of the country of origin shall not be discriminated against, provided the ring is sealed.
- 1.6. The first ring order of every year shall be issued at the championship show and only to club secretaries or their designates.
- 1.7. Rings shall only be issued by the SASPO Ringmaster to the clubs affiliated to the organisation. Members are not allowed to order rings directly from the Ringmaster.
- 1.8. The Ringmaster shall not be allowed to process any late ring orders or ring orders that are not accompanied by proof of payment.
- 1.9. Rings shall only be issued in multiples of 10.
- 1.10. Rings shall only be issued by clubs to members affiliated to the organisation. Club secretaries shall keep complete records of rings issued to members.
- 1.11. The price, at which rings are issued to clubs, shall be determined annually by the Ringmaster, subject to approval by the SASPO Executive Committee.
- 1.12. The price at which clubs issue rings to their members, shall be determined and approved annually by the SASPO Committee at the SASPO Committee meeting held in February.
- 1.13. There shall be three (3) ring orders annually. Should there be an additional order due to large demand, this order will be subject to approval by the SASPO Chairman and subject to penalties.
- 1.14. Any bird wearing a ring larger than the size specified shall be disqualified from participation.
- 1.15. Judges should first consult with the show committee before disqualifying an exhibit bearing a wrong size ring.
- 1.16. Any change in the ring size of a breed shall be approved by the SASPO Committee and published on the SASPO web site.
- 1.17. Ring sizes applicable to all birds will be updated and/or revised on an annual basis and the details of the sizes will be furnished on the back of the ring order forms. It can also be found on the SASPO web site.
- 1.18. All waterfowl must be rung from 2014 onwards.
- 1.19. A bird rung with a ring of a certain breeding season is allowed to be shown as a young bird till the end of the following calendar year.
- 1.20. Example: A bird rung with a 2015 (red) ring is allowed to be shown as a young bird from August 2015 till December 2016.
