The Crested is one of the less common ducks, somewhat like the Orpington in size and shape. The ducklings do not all have crests when hatched; the plain headed ones being easily distinguished from the crested.

GENERAL CHARACTERISTICS

DRAKE AND DUCK

Carriage: Somewhat erect.

Type: Body: long, broad and fairly deep. Full round breast. Long broad back. Strong wings carried closely. Tail: short, similar to that of the Aylesbury.

Head: Straight and long. Large globular crest, set evenly on the skull. Bill: long and broad. Eyes: large and bright.

Neck: Medium length.

Legs and Feet: Short and strong. Toes: straight.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

Slipped wings. Any deformity.

COLOUR

Any duck colour permitted.
