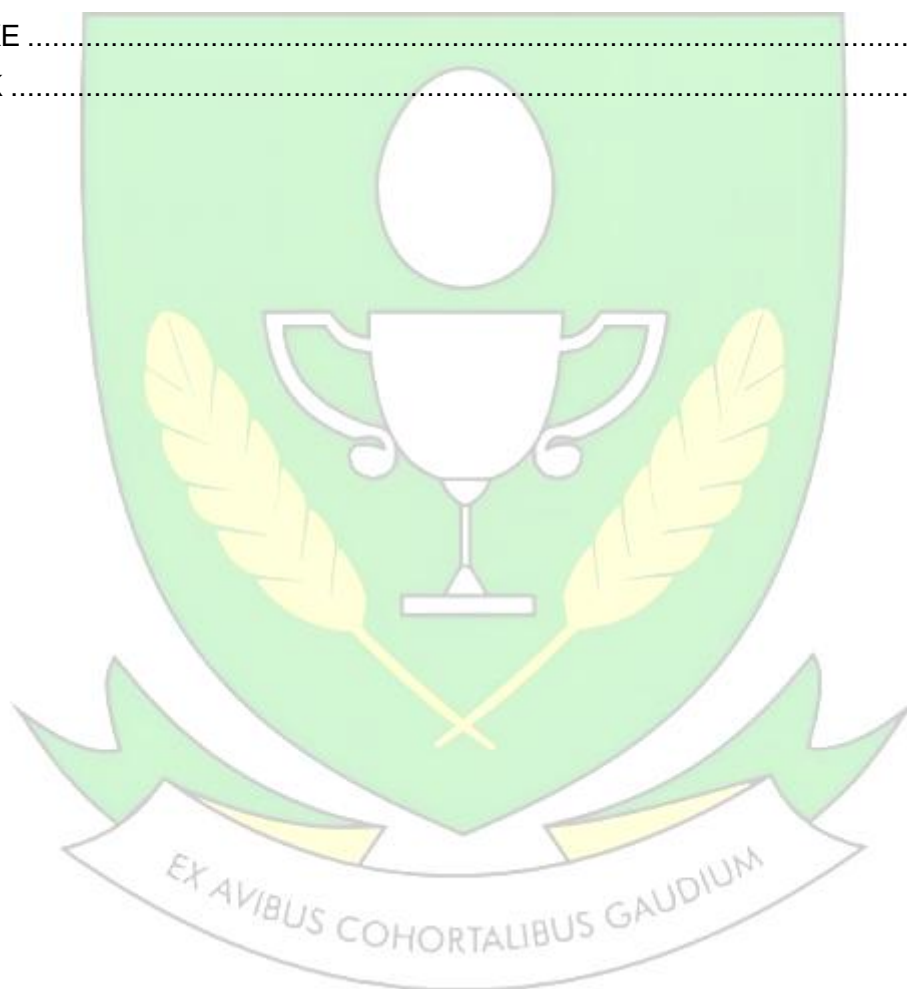

GIMBSHEIMER

The Gimbsheimer was bred from the Orpington, American Pekin and Saxony in Gimbsheim between 1958 and 1963.

GENERAL CHARACTERISTICS

DRAKE AND DUCK

Carriage: Lively and alert. Carriage: slightly elevated and clear of the ground.

Type: Body: long, broad and deep without any sign of keel. Breast: full and well round. Back: slightly elevated but not plump. Wings: carried close to sides.

Head: Long, not too wide but well rounded with a flat forehead. Bill: moderate length and fairly straight from base to tip in line with highest point of skull.

Neck: Moderate length, slightly curved, slender and upright.

Legs and Feet: Moderate length. Feet: straight and webbed, set almost in the middle of the body.

Plumage: Tight and glossy.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

Colour other than stated. White wing feathers, brown breast. Carriage too upright. Head out of proportion.

DRAKE

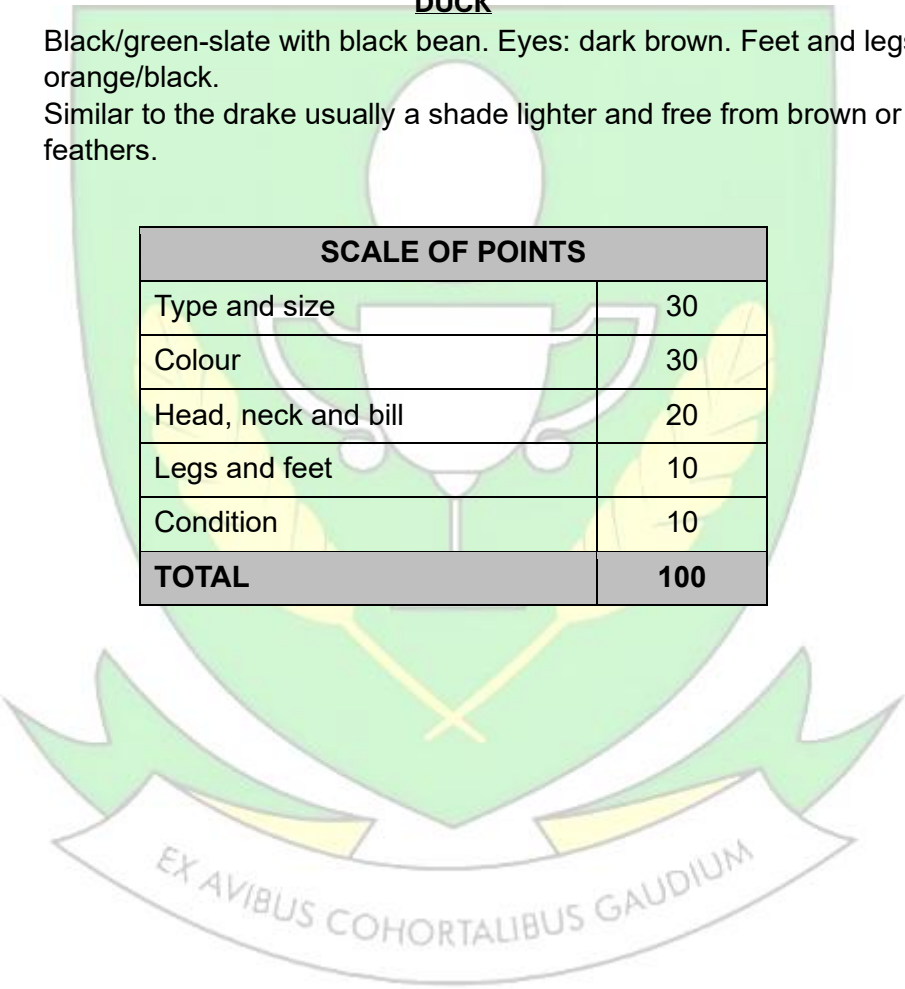
Bill: Meadow green with black bean. Eyes: dark brown. Feet and legs: range/black.

Plumage: Rich even shade of blue grey over the whole body, head and neck a darker shade (sometimes almost black); a lighter shade permissible on the wing bar.

DUCK

Bill: Black/green-slate with black bean. Eyes: dark brown. Feet and legs: orange/black.

Plumage: Similar to the drake usually a shade lighter and free from brown or white feathers.
